

Mark your boxes.

We are sure you would want to find the right boxes in the right room of your new home.

There's one golden rule: thorough marking avoids time-consuming search operations.

Use a thick pen to write the place of destination (bathroom, living room, etc.) on the top side of each box. You should also describe the main contents of each box (books, porcelain, clothes, DVD / CD, etc.).

It is also important to clearly mark special individual items. You wouldn't really spend the first night in your new home looking for the cables of the stereo system or the loudspeakers, the connection cable for the TV set or the remote control in about 75 boxes spread over the whole premises.

Clear marking makes unpacking at the place of destination much easier. Please bear in mind that you may have additional rooms at your new premises and want to have some pieces of furniture placed in other rooms than at the old flat/house. Think about it when you mark you removal boxes.
